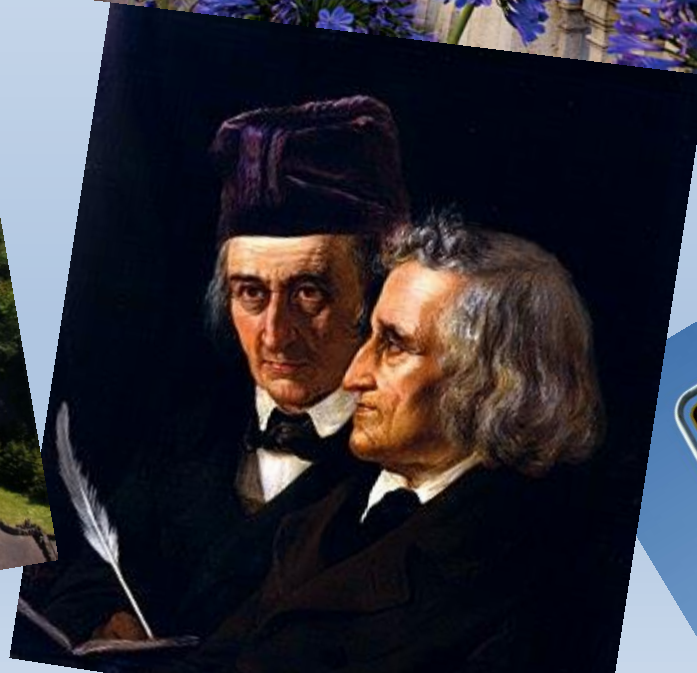

CSSG 2019: Costs

- One tuition fee for all
- No international student differential fee
- = \$1,672 (6 credit hours)
- Plus program fee
- = approximately \$2,800 (confirmed at end of January 2019)
- Value for money. This includes for six & a half weeks: Textbooks, study materials, accommodation in Kassel, meals in Kassel (except lunch on school days), cultural & social activities (museums, plays, concerts, opera, German movies, etc.), local transit pass (bus & tram), and excursions (transport, accommodation, meals, activities, etc.)
- *Does not include airfare to/from Germany and personal discretionary spending*
